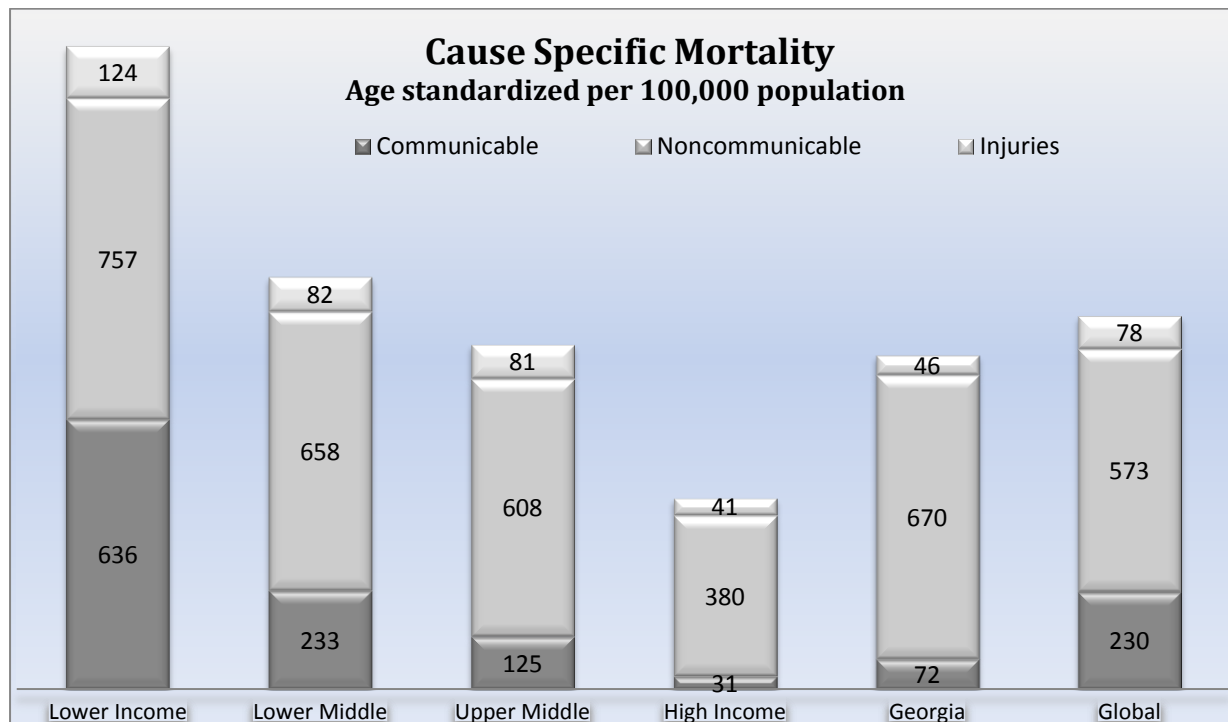


Figure 1 WHO standardized classifications of Mortality Rates – Communicable, Non-communicable, and Injuries [THE 2011 World Health Statistics Report].

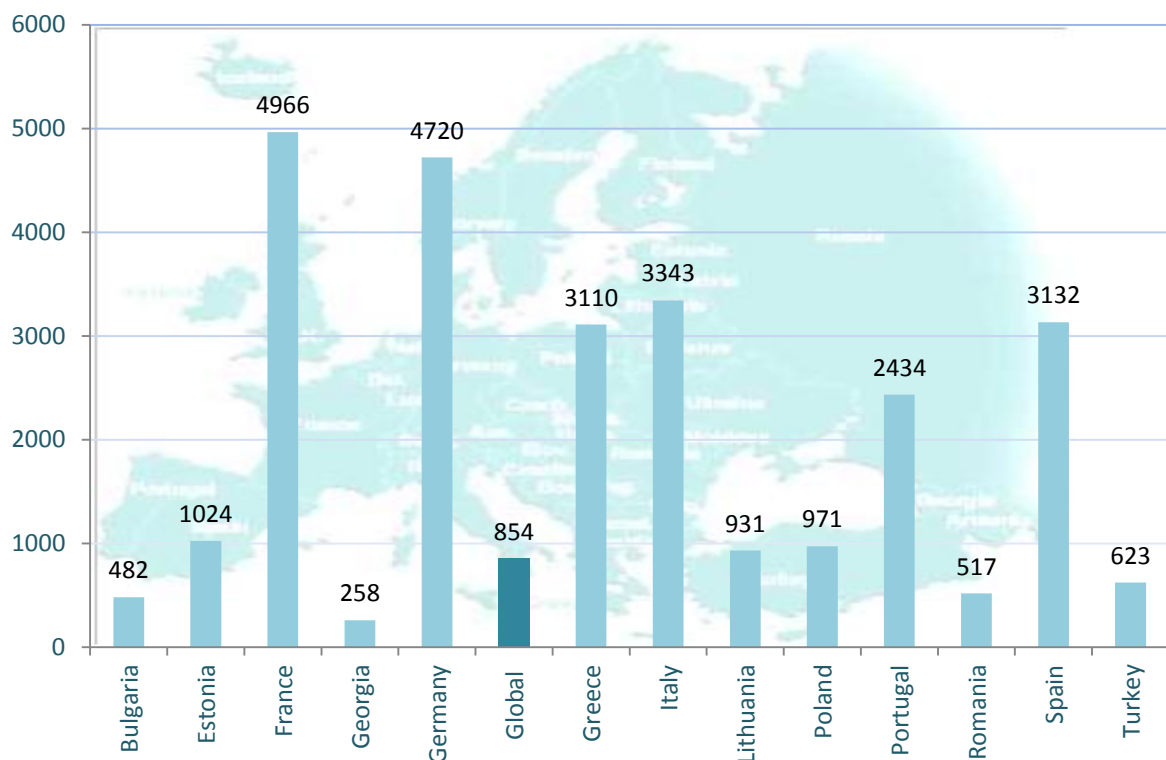


Figure 2 Comparison of Per capita total expenditure on health at average exchange rate (US\$) with select EuSEM Federation Members. [THE 2011 World Health Statistics Report]

HEALTHCARE EXPENDITURE BY SECTOR

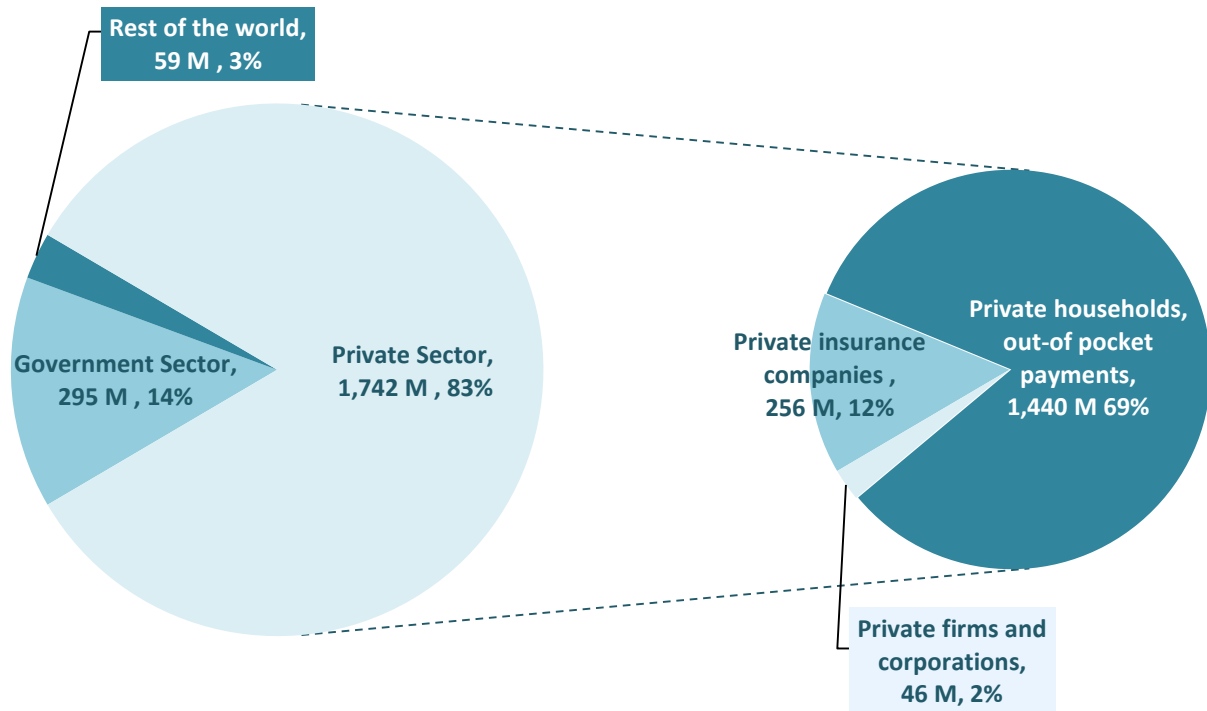


Figure 3 According to The 2010 Georgian Ministry of Health (MoLHSA) figures, the total expenditure on health was 2 billion (2,096,492,094 GEL) Georgian Lari (1 USD = 1.65 GEL).

From the Total Healthcare Expenditure in Georgia of just over 2 Billion Lari, 7 and ½ Million is spent on Education and Training of Healthcare Providers corresponding to 0.375%

For the 40,000 Doctors and Nurses working in Georgia this corresponds to an average of 188 GEL [\$110 USD] per Healthcare Worker per year.
