Course Overview

The EUSEM 1st Certification of Non-Invasive Ventilation Course is a comprehensive programme that equips Emergency Medicine professionals with the necessary knowledge and skills to manage acute respiratory failure using non-invasive respiratory support effectively. The course covers COVID-19 and non-COVID-19 cases, and it's intended for senior trainees and consultants in their first five years of practice.

Course Objectives

- Understand pathophysiology of acute respiratory failure and the effects of Non-Invasive respiratory support in COVID19 and non-COVID19 acute respiratory failure
- Understand indications and contraindications of the various methods
- Apply problem-solving to manage ventilators troubleshooting
- Understand pros and cons of Non-Invasive respiratory support in COVID19 patients
