

E-learning courses are designed around specific topics from the European EM curriculum and are aimed at all practitioners of Emergency Medicine and all those providing Emergency Care. EM Monthly Webinar

EM Monthly was launched at the beginning of 2021 as a webinar series. EM Monthly is held every last Thursday of the month with relevant and important topics in Emergency Medicine. This platform reaches a wide range of EM Physicians from around the world. The main goal is education and every webinar is therefore also uploaded on the EUSEM academy.

Research Projects

EUSEM undertakes a wide range of research activities from conducting surveys to running observational studies. The EUSEM research committee and research network are developing and overseeing over 5 research projects across Europe. Through the Research Network, it has the capacity to collaborate with professionals and researchers working in ED and prehospital care across 30 countries. EUSEM collaborates with many other academic societies, such as ERC, ACVC, ESICM, EFMI, EMCREG & IFEM reaching a large number of institutes globally.

Refresher Course

EUSEM refresher courses are organized throughout Europe, led by acknowledged experts and concentrate on improving skills and knowledge of young doctors. These courses attract a wide range of attendees from all areas of Emergency care and they are an opportunity for trainees and EM specialists to learn new techniques and skills and familiarise themselves with new equipment / devices.

European Board Exam in Emergency Medicine

The European Board Examination in Emergency Medicine (EBEEM) is developed and implemented by EMERGE (Emergency Medicine Examination Reference Group in Europe). This two-part examination assesses the knowledge, skills and behaviours necessary for the clinical practice of Emergency Medicine at the level of the specialist or consultant engaged in independent practice, confirming that the successful candidate is able to provide clinical leadership in the emergency department.
